# ADDENDUM: ARMY RECRUITMENT RALLY- RECRUITING OFFICE (HQ) CHENNAI AT ARUNAI ENGINEERING COLLEGE STADIUM, TIRUVANNAMALAI (T.N)

- 1. It is informed that Army Recruitment Rally earlier scheduled from 15 April 2020 to 25 April 2020 will now be held from 10 February 2021 to 26 February 2021.
- 2. <u>Venue</u>. Arunai Engineering College Stadium, Tiruvannamalai (T.N).
- 3 <u>Eligibility</u> All candidates who had earlier applied for the Rally are only eligible.
- 4. <u>Latest Policies</u>. Latest policies regarding sports certificates and standard for weight are as under:
  - (a) **Sports**. The sports certificates issued by authorised sports federations are valid for two years from the issue date as on first day of the recruitment rally, for which the candidate is being screened. For list of sports under which relaxation in physical standards is admissible attention is invited to <a href="www.joinindianarmy.nic.in">www.joinindianarmy.nic.in</a> website. Sports certificates should be with registration number and from government recognized sports institutes/ bodies as under:-

- 5. <u>Conduct Of Rally During COVID</u>. In view of the ongoing COVID 19 situation the rally will be conducted in the following manner to ensure maximum precautions:-
  - (a) Not more than 2000 candidates will be screened per day. Day wise admit cards will be issued accordingly.
  - (b) The candidates in batches of 500 each will be required to report to four different Report Centres (RC 1, RC 2, RC 3 & RC 4) which will be in the close proximity of Arunai Engineering College, Tiruvannamalai. RC 1 will also be the main screening site.
  - (c) <u>Rally Token</u>. On reporting to respective Report Centers (RC 2, RC 3, RC 4), candidates will be issued with tokens for participating in the Rally at RC 1. Possession of these tokens is mandatory to appear for the rally.
  - (d) Candidates after having reported to their Report Centre will continue to remain there & will be moved to the screening site (RC1) in batches based on progress of screening in RC 1.
  - (e) Report Centres. The details of the above four Report Centres will be uploaded on the Join Indian Army Website after issue of admit cards. Candidates are advised to keep checking the site for the same. Each candidate will be allowed to report only at the Report Centre nominated/specified for him for collection of Rally token.

6 <u>COVID-19 Certificate</u> All candidates will produce a mandatory <u>COVID-19 Free Certificate</u> and <u>No Risk Certificate</u> when they report for the rally. Format attached as **Annx I & II** respectively Covid – 19 test should have been carried out 72 – 96 hours prior to the rally reporting day.

#### COVID-19 Advisory.

- (a) Candidates will be thermally screened at the rally site. Candidates having temperature / showing symptoms will be directed to report again on a designated day earmarked by Recruiting Staff, for all such cases. If the candidate is again having symptoms, he will not be allowed to participate in the Rally.
- (b) All candidates will carry masks, gloves & hand sanitizers.

#### (c) <u>DO's and DON'Ts While In Recruitment Rally.</u>

- (i) Wear mask at all the time and before putting on mask, clean with soap and water. Replace mask with a new one as soon as it is damp and do not re-use single use mask.
- (ii) Regularly and thoroughly clean your hands with soap, water or sanitizer during verification of documents and prior to appearing for the test. The same will be available at site.
- (iii) Maintain social distancing as per government orders amongst each other. Don't touch your body parts on any surface unnecessarily.
- (iv) Maintain good respiratory hygiene ie cover your mouth and nose with tissue paper during cough or sneezing. Then dispose off the used tissue immediately in the covered dustbin and wash your hand with soap, water or sanitizer.
- (v) Inform and seek immediate medical attention in case of fever, cough and difficulty in breathing.
- (vi) Candidates are required to carry the mask and hand sanitizer alongwith them.
- (vii) Finally, be supportive, be careful, be alert and be safe.
- 8. <u>Issue of Admit Card</u>. Admit Cards will be issued online from last week of January 2021 onwards. Please keep checking your registered e-mail IDs & join Indian Army Website for the same.
- 9. <u>Details of Report Centre</u>. The details of the four Report Centres will be uploaded on the Join Indian Army Website after issue of admit cards. Candidates are advised to keep checking the site for the same. Each candidate will be allowed to report only at the Report Centre nominated/specified for him for collection of Rally token.
